Firefighter/EMT-Paramedic

The West Boylston Fire Department is seeking applications to fill the position of Firefighter/EMT-Paramedic.

Position Description: Performs highly responsible functions in the direct delivery of fire suppression and emergency medical services. Duties include care, maintenance of fire apparatus, tools, equipment, etc. Also assists in fire prevention activities, public education, inspections and pre-incident planning. A complete job description is available upon request.

Minimum Qualifications: High School diploma or equivalent required, two (2) years or greater experience in an organized Fire Department; Massachusetts certified Firefighter I/II; Massachusetts certified Emergency Medical Technician-Paramedic; current CPR/DEFIB card; active Class D driver's license.

Candidates must possess excellent oral and written communication skills, present a positive public image and be in good physical condition. In addition, must have mechanical and computer aptitude, work both independently and in a team environment in a manner that contributes to the enhancement and success of the organization.

Candidates must be a non-smoker and will be subject to a thorough background/reference check, pre-employment psychological evaluation and physical.

Candidates must reside in one of the following zip code locations within a reasonable time of appointment as determined by the employer: 01583, 01505, 01520, 01564, 01606.

Salary/Benefits: Starting salary is \$16.83—\$18.39 per hour. Position works a 48 hour work week and is subject to being on-call and emergency call back. Schedule may be fixed or rotating at the sole discretion of the employer. Full Town benefits including health insurance, optional dental insurance, education reimbursement and Worcester Regional Retirement System.
