## Town of West Boylston Finance and CIB Committee Meeting of May 15, 2017

A meeting of Fincom and CIB was convened at 6:24 pm in the cafeteria of the WB high school prior to the May 15 town meeting. Attending were Chris Berglund, Paul Bohnson, Ray Bricault, Jaime Desanti, Bill Fay, James Marinelli, and Pete Murphy. Absent were Pat Bryant and Pavel Loven.

The remaining articles on the Town Meeting Warrant that require action were reviewed:

- Articles 8 Transfer Funds, The transfer details were reviewed. The total is \$417,110 with snow removal overrun of \$356,110 the largest single item.
   Ray Bricault moved to endorse the article, Jim Marinelli seconded. The vote to approve for Fincom was 7-0 and the motion was approved.
- Article 10 Previous Years Bills, Only one bill was presented, an FY16 VA benefit for \$1,952. Paul Bohnson moved to endorse the article, Jim Marinelli seconded. The vote to approve for Fincom was 7-0 and the motion was approved.
- Article 11 Sewer Enterprise, The Sewer Enterprise proposed budget was
  discussed. There is an increasing administrative cost and a new capital line.
  Fincom agreed that a more thorough review is required later in the year.
  Pete Murphy moved to endorse the article, Ray Bricault seconded. The vote
  to approve for Fincom was 7-0 and the motion was approved.
- Article 18 Parks Pesticide, The town administrator agreed that this item will be moved to the next operating budget in FY18. Ray Bricault moved to endorse the article, Paul Bohnson seconded. The vote to approve for Fincom was 7-0 and the motion was approved.
- Article 21 Unemployment Trust, A \$5,000 excess in the insurance budget is to be moved to the trust for unexpected insurance costs. Ray Bricault moved to endorse the article, Jim Marinelli seconded. The vote to approve for Fincom was 7-0 and the motion was approved.

The committee decided not to revisit the Senior Center article.

The meeting was adjourned at 6:50 pm.
