April 11-15 – Prospect St, Woodland St, Thomas St, North Main St, Laurel St, Ray Huntington Hwy, Beaman St, Prescott St, Fairbanks St.

April 19 – 21 - School Parking Lots.

NEIGHBORHOOD STREETS

April 22 - 29: Battlegrounds (Yorktown, Bunker Hill, Trenton, Lexington, Kings Mt, etc.), Hills (Maplewood, Highland, Peachtree, Hartwell, Edgewood, Harvard, Hartwell, Yale, Bonnieview, Chino etc.), Flats (Lebanon, Lombard, Bowles, Carew, Buckingham, Chapman, etc.)

May 2 - 6: Shrine Ave, Cavour Circle, Helen Dr, Carol Dr, Cross St, Phillips, Davidson, Westland Circle, Mary, Edwards St, Woodland Hts, Center St, Alpine, Pheasant Hill, Meadowbrook, Blueridge, Hawthorne, Shenandoah, Danielian, Cumberland, Osgood, Pinecroft Av, Lost Oak, Parker, Glenwood, etc.

May 9 – 13: Evans Rd, Parker St, Lawrence St, Applewood Rd, Scarlett St, Colonial Hill (Bowen, Henry, Monticello, etc.)

May 16 – 20: Marsh Hawk, Blake, Phelps, Old Century Farm, Pine Arden, Townsend, Lynwood Lane, Horseshoe (Western Ave, Birch St, Sterling Place), Campground Rd, Lancaster Meadows, Heritage Lane, Horseshoe Dr (Linden, Elm, Wood, Holt, Winthrop, Reagan Cir, Shady Lane)

May 23 - 27: Memorial Day Preparation (Parade Route and Cemetery) Keyes, Hosmer, Rivington Est, Reed, Cutting, Lisa, Almanac, Wauschacum, Stillwater Hts, May, High, Green, Foster, etc.

The West Boylston Department of Public Works will begin street sweeping on March 28, 2016. This schedule will be followed as closely as possible with the chance of delays due to inclement weather, equipment breakdowns, emergencies, etc; or with the chance of acceleration. Updates will be provided on DPW News through the Town website.

It is imperative that residents not place any debris (sticks, trash, rocks) in the street that may damage the equipment. Please do not park on the street during your scheduled week.
