motion by Karen + 2nd by Janet
to approve - unanimous

Thank You note from Kayla Meade
a scholarship recipient read
by Joyce

Joyce checked w/ Town as to
5854^{\$1} in scholarship funds
as of ~~6-30~~ 7-1-19 but \$ 2000
still owed to Kayla + Monica of
past recipients
approx. \$525 increase

We gave out only 2 scholarships
last time

Joyce - money coming in is a
lot less than the \$ going out

Joyce introduced a letter dated
10-15-19 from Douglas Horka, Veterans
Service Officer, Town of West
Boylston as to them awarding
\$500 per scholarship

Karen - do they give 1, 2 or 3
scholarships

Karen offered to e-mail him
but Joyce will talk to Mr.
Horka in person as to what this
entails

Karen - does he want us to
handle it

Joyce - they ask of their
application for total family
income

Can we put it on our application
because they do.

Bernie was asked by Joyce if
asking income was allowed
& Bernie responded no

We all agreed unanimously that

we would offer one student from
the h.s. + one adult (post
high school) each for \$1000 for
a total of \$2000

Karen: "there is only one more
year we can afford scholarships"

We spoke of newer businesses
(i.e. marijuana) coming into town
and their possibly contributing
\$ or tax \$ receipts

Joyce: we have given out 52
scholarships from 2007 thru
2017

Joyce + Bevie were the only
members on the committee at that
time

On 2007 we had \$31,000 in
the fund

We have been C \$1000 each
scholarship since 2009 +
some recipients got it more

than once i.e. Novia + Mendenhall

Karen likes that recipient can be post high school

Joyce - we had mothers going back to school for maybe dental hygienists & we wanted to reward them

Karen questioned why we don't require letter of recommendation & Joyce addressed that it is a lot of work for the secretary at the school

Karen - a letter of recommendation would talk of the student's character which would meet State guidelines

Bernie stated we should leave the application process alone other than slight changes we have made over the 10 years & we basically all agreed after discussion to not change any requirements
