- One boiler is still out of order. Emcor has been able to find a replacement for the broken component, but still cannot find an ignitor rod, so the boiler would still be down even if repairs are made. Waiting for an ignitor rod to be located.
- A rodent issue was discovered. A service call has been placed with a pest control company; service is pending.
- Mark Pruneau completed repairs on the window leak issue.
- Attic stairs not yet replaced, rescheduled since Mark Pruneau was working on the windows first.
- First draft of FY25 Budget Request was submitted to Town Administrator on 1/12/24.
- Finishing touches are being put on the newsletter. Will be mailed week of 2/19.
- Summer program planning to begin in early March
- Review of existing library policies is under way. Requested feedback from staff on policies that may need adjustment or policies that frequently cause tension between staff and patrons.
- Daymarc grant was received by the Friends of the Library
