Discussion

- Financial statements: Municipal appropriations status reports as available. Library accounts match the Town's for the period of July 1, 2018–November 30, 2018.
- Director attended Central MA Regional IT group on Nov. 29th;
 Town has applied for an audit of IT systems. Director requested that Library be part of this audit.
- Library was used for 50 events and meetings in October.
- WB Police walk-through took place on Nov. 1.
- Elevator passed re-inspection on Nov. 8th.
- Discussion of woodpecker problems; there are six current holes as of this meeting. Director met with V&S Finishing and reached out to the Department of Fish & Wildlife.
- A permanent crosswalk added to Newton Street on Nov. 30.
- We have been having problems with the website, which was originally done in 2012. Director requested help from the web developer who helped create it. Meeting scheduled. Computer problems are ongoing; Director requested Town funds to assist with tech purchases and repairs.
- Library is looking for new volunteers.

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OLD BUSINESS

- No additional news on independent boiler consultant.
- Job description classification update: still a work in progress.
 Director and some Trustees met with Personnel Board. Town is getting state grant funding to compare classifications with similar MA towns. State will be involved in identifying towns.
- CORI checks will be implemented with staff.
- Lighting Department project will be installed in the spring.
 Timer installation estimated at \$250.
- Building maintenance account balance was \$423.75, but we received a grant (\$2276) from the Town's insurance company for sprinkler repair and rewiring condensate pump.
- Town has an interim Building Inspector.
- Endowment Event on April 5, 2019.

- Discussion of draft budget and impacts of level-funded budget.
- Reviewed and discussed Employee Engagement Survey draft.
