**NEW BUSINESS: Land Survey** 

Mr. Smith of Tauper Land Survey is present to discuss the access and location of the proposed development of the senior housing development at 87 Maple Street. Access from Temple Street is not feasible because it is a drainage area for the wetlands. The access beside the Bonci property is not acceptable. The best access is the current entry to the property. The width of the present driveway is of concern as the number of trips will be increased. Mr. Smith will define the roadway width. Also discussed is the planning board considerations. Is this to be considered a parcel or a lot as there is insufficient frontage One parcel of 19.73 acres to be leased to the developer and 2 easements given to the developer for access and drainage. In the opinion of Mr. Smith because the property is a parcel and will not be divided the property boundaries do not change and therefore the land court decision stands. Also of concern is an area of wetland next to the present garage which is the .probably the best access to the development area. Mr. Vignaly, Mr. Smith and Mr. Barrell will walk the site for evaluation. Mr. Smith will draw a plan showing the proposed driveway.

Mr. Smith also stated that the issue with the land court regarding the boundary between the Mr. Gambaccini and the housing Authority is resolved. Ms. Halpin inquired if it possible to obtain this in writing. Mr. Smith stated it is unlikely and should not be a problem. He will check.

NEXT TOPIC Letter from DHCD Ms. Stuart reviewed the letter received from DHCD to Marcia Cairns, Chair of the Housing Authority, dated February 7, 2018 approving the transfer of housing authority land for senior housing with conditions. This is a positive development. A meeting with the Housing Authority needs to be scheduled.
