BOA authorizes Diane Peterson (primary) and Dennis Fitzpatrick (secondary) to approve all payroll expenditures related to Assessors' Office. Myra Fortugno is authorized to be the primary approver of all *other* expenditures (non-payroll).

- 6. Exemption Discussion Diane Peterson discussed the possibility of lowering the interest rate of 8% on the Statutory Exemption 41A. Dennis Fitzpatrick made a motion to: Decrease the interest rate from 8% to 4% for 41A exemptions. Jim Swalec 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion. Item will be brought to May Town Meeting to be approved by voters.
- 7. Military Reservists active in Foreign Countries- Discussion of a possible 100% real estate reduction for 2 years while in active duty
