Meeting Minutes

***Chairman Barrell convened the meeting at 7:00 p.m.***

**Administrative Hearing (Finder's Pub):** Kevin McCormick (Finder's Pub Owner) was requested to come before the Board of Health in regards to non-compliant violations within the inspection reports from July 18, 2016, August 4, 2016, September 9, 2016, November 9, 2016, February 15, 2017, May 10, 2017, and June 20, 2017; as well as the history with the high number of serious and repeated violations of Chapter X of the State Sanitary Code 105 CMR 590.000. After discussion of the violations listed in the inspectional report as well as a history of repeated violations, Finder's Pub has agreed to following corrective actions by August 1, 2017.

**CMRPHA Updates:** China Express changed their name to Miku, as well as changed their menu. They have been approved and got OK to open. Tattoo regulations were corrected and approved, they will be put into effect as of August 1, 2017. Blighting regulations in regards to abandoned properties where lawns and property itself not being maintained. A by-law would need to be created at a town meeting.

**Opioid Event:** Myles Leo (Public Health Prevention Specialist) shared ideas of how to host another Opioid Event. He stated that working with the community and local law enforcement is very beneficial. Including schools, churches and parents.

**Pay Bills:** Bills were reviewed and approved for payment.

**8 Heritage Lane:** A septic design repair was presented to the Board of Health for 8 Heritage Lane. Upon review, it was recommended that revisions be made the designer, before the board could approve anything.
