TOWN OF WEST BOYLSTON BOARD OF SELECTMEN POLICY

Policy on Public Hearing Process for Business License Violations

Purpose:

The Board of Selectmen agrees to establish procedures to follow for public hearings related to business license violations.

Policy:

The following process will be followed for

- 1. Hearing will be opened by the Chairman of the Board who will read the public notice into the record.
- 2. All parties who intend to testify will be sworn in.
- 3. Complainant will provide testimony and any witnesses.
- 4. Board members will have an opportunity to question complainant and witnesses. All questions will be directed through the Chairman
- 5. Respondent provides testimony and any witnesses.
- 6. Board members will have an opportunity to question respondent and witnesses.
- 7. Final statement/rebuttal by the complainant.
- 8. Final statement/rebuttal by the respondent.
- 9. Selectmen will ask clarifying questions as necessary.
- 10. The public hearing will be closed.
- 11. The Board will deliberate.
- 12. The Board will vote its finding as to whether there was a violation.
- 13. Should the Board vote that in fact there was a violation they will then vote the penalty.
