Minutes of August 30, 2017 were approved. Upon motion of Chris Rucho and second by it was voted unanimously to confirm the vote of August 30, 2017 to authorize Patrick Crowley, as chair, and Steve Blake in his absence, to sign invoices for approved applications.

Patrick Crowley distributed copies of financial statement.

Upon the motion of Chris Rucho and the second of Vincent Vignaly it was unanimously voted to approve the payment of \$850 to the Community Preservation Coalition for annual dues support.

Colleen Abrams of the Wachusett Greenways outlined the plans to extend the rail trail to connect the trail from Parking lot over 140 causeway to Pleasant Street. The project would require a bridge adjacent to highway and the figure of \$3 million was proposed as cost of project. Ms Abrams hopes for a strong commitment from West Boylston CPA funds to the project together with grants from foundations and the state. Questions arose as to use

since construction would partially be on DCR land and subject therefore to DCR regulations. The rail trail is a valued resource for recreation by West Boylston residents. Ms Abrams was encouraged to create conceptual drawings to accompany the formal submission of the project. Such drawings could then be used to educate residents should the project get recommended for town meeting consideration.
