
As we enter into our winter weather- some reminders: Watch for school closings as the center closes when schools are closed. Sign up for walkway shoveling with help from our high school students.

### **January Fun Facts**



January was named for the Roman god Janus, known as the protector of gates and doorways, who symbolizes beginnings and endings. Janus is depicted with two faces, one looking into the past, the other with the ability to see into the future. What a fitting symbol for this first day of the year; this month is our door into the new year.

January was excluded from the Roman calendar which only had 10 months. King Numa Pompilius, the second king of Rome, is responsible for adding both January and February to

the Roman calendar. He did this so calendars would be equivalent to a lunar year. Even so, it only had 30 days. The 31st day of January was added to the month by Julius Caesar.

In leap years, January always starts on the same day as April and July.

Oddly enough, couples tend to separate or divorce more so in January than in any other month of the year.
