

When they do, there is confusion, panic and urgency. Paramedics arrive on the scene with no information about the person in need. Seconds count - they can make the difference between life and death. We urge everyone to have one in their home (even in your wallet).

Following the File of Life aide, the nurse will remain for a blood pressure clinic. For those needing a monthly record, please take advantage of this program.


Blow Off Steam:

It took years for trainmen to learn how to handle locomotives. Hot fires were required in order to keep up enough steam to move. But when an engine halted, steam pressure could rise quickly. There were no safety valves; at intervals, the engineer had to pull a lever and blow off the steam to prevent an explosion.

In the 1830's, a locomotive was a thing of awe when quiet and still. A person who for the first time saw the iron monster blow off steam never forgot the incident.

Observers compared such an explosive incident with a sudden display of temper. Soon adopted into the speech of merchants and travelers, anyone indulging in a colorful outburst was said to "blow off steam."
