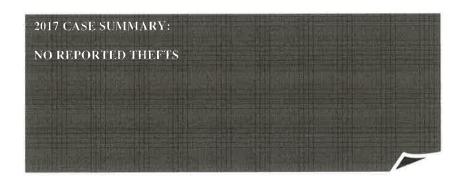

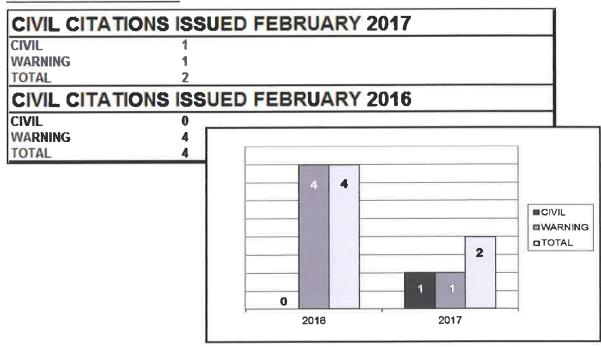

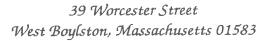

This is the monthly report of activities and projects for the West Boylston Fire Department, for the month of February 2017.

- Regional dispatch update, Paramedic Fiske continues in-house training with the call members and officers, as we get a new start date of April 4th, 2017.
- Meet with the department heads and the CMRPC, to work on a plan for future projects, here in West Boylston.
- Reviewed the FY 2018 budget with the Town Administrator. Expressed concern the Fire Department needs the attention of FINCOM, with capital purchases.
- Reviewed the CODE RED System, reviewed sign in and procedures to use system in an emergency.
- Continue inspections and follow up on the Curtis Industry, 94 North Main Street and 99 Hartwell Street projects.
- Working with the American Legion to see that the fire alarm and suppression systems are being installed as agree to.
- The decision was made not to pursue the SAFER Grant this year. Going for 1 firefighter was not enough and three firefighter's was too much of a financial burden, on the Town for the next three years. Will relook at and strongly push for three firefighters, in the next AFG.
- Walk thru the Reservoir Motel, with the new owners and building inspector, to see if it would be a training opportunity before it is razed, for the Condo proposal.
- Started planning for the Public Safety Building, with the Police Department moving out in July 2017. The Town Administrator asked that the full-time staff give their input and ideas, on the lay out of the facility.
- The Fire Department began working with an intern from the High School.

VETERANS, WIDOWS AND FAMILIES SERVED

During the month of February 2017, the Veterans' Service Office stabilized the number of West Boylston residents being served with Veterans/Widows/Family benefits to **eleven clients**. This is an increase of ONE from January's total of ten clients. These benefits are commonly known as Chapter 115 Veterans Benefits. One formerly disqualified client was reinstated when her 2017 information provided access which had been previously denied.

The Veterans' Service Department is budgeted for FY2017 at approximately \$8,600 per month as the average expenditure ... but that budget was established using a basis of 15 clients. Now, with only 11 clients to serve, it is expect that the monthly expenditure will average just over \$6,200 per month inclusive of both fixed and variable costs.

Note: During February, several clients received benefits at their 2016 rate while the Veterans Service Office was awaiting approval from the Department of Veterans Service in Boston. During mid-January when feedback from Boston was received, it was determined that two clients were "overpaid", thus inflating the total disbursement and average monthly pay-out values. The overpayments will be resolved during March and April 2017.

Year-to-date, West Boylston Veteran benefits/distributions are **FAVORABLE** to the FY2017 budget by **\$6,448.49** (after 8 months).
