Attached please find the monthly reports for March.

Of note in the Expenditure Report, I offer the following –

The accounts noted in the February reports (Computer P/S, WBPA Salaries, Bldg Dpt Salaries) are still being monitored for possible adjustment needed at Town Meeting. WBPA and IT have been made aware of the balance concerns.

Additional departments/accounts that are being monitored (Department heads have been made aware of low balances) are Fire, Dispatch, Police, and DPW. Police do have plans to propose budget fixes at Town Meeting. DPW has been advised to limit spending. Dispatch is running very low, however, the fees due to Holden for dispatch services have been paid through 6/30/18, thus the percentage spent would be distorted. Fire is likely to submit a budget fix at Town Meeting.

Subject: Veterans' Service Office Executive Summary for the month of **March 2018**

- VETERANS, WIDOWS AND FAMILIES SERVED**

The month of **March 2018**, the Veterans' Service Office concluded with West Boylston serving only **nine** Veterans/Widows/Families with the State Veterans Benefits. One additional client has had his benefits suspended while he is out of state. He will not return until mid-April, at which time he will have to be recertified in order to become eligible for benefits again. Also, as of the end of March, there is one additional candidate under consideration while his application information is being compiled. It is expected that he will become eligible during April.

The Veterans' Service Department is budgeted for FY2018 at \$120,000 or \$10,000 per month as an average expenditure. I believe that this is GROSSLY overstated. Using recently completed FY 2017 performance, I do not expect that the Veterans Service Department will spend more than \$6,500 per month (as long as the number of beneficiaries does not significantly change). This forecast includes the total of both fixed and variable costs (reimbursements of monthly medical co-pays).

Assuming that the number of Veterans qualifying for benefits does not significantly change from the present enrollment of nine/ten/eleven during second half of FY2018, it is projected that the Department will complete the year approximately 35% UNDER budget.

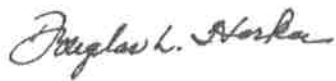
- **LOOKING FORWARD**

One of West Boylston's Veteran Beneficiaries has had his benefits suspended during the period from January to April while he is out of State (in Florida). The DVS ruling is that a beneficiary is not eligible for benefits during out-of-state absences greater than 7 days. The Veteran will be re-established when he returns to West Boylston in April. The immediate impact is only a savings of \$335.00 per month during his absence.

On Tuesday, April 10th, I have been asked to participate in a forum "Upgrading Bad Paper (upgrading an unfavorable military discharge)" being held in Northampton. Although the forum is being held from 10:00 to Noon, because of the commute, I will be out of the office for the majority of the day.
