Chapter 44, Section 7(3) and/or any other enabling authority and to issue bonds or notes of the Town therefore provided, however, that the appropriation authorized hereunder shall be contingent upon approval by the voters of a ballot question to exclude the amounts required to pay for the bond or notes issued for such project from the provisions of Proposition 2 ½, so called.
