Declaration of Covenants --- order of events – for Home Occupation special permit

- 1. Applicant applies for building permit and is denied
- 2. Zoning Interpretation Request Form is filled in by Building Department and brought to ZBA by the applicant / property owner in order for petition to be heard
- 3. ZBA creates DECLARATION OF COVENANTS HOME OCCUPATION SPECIAL PERMIT form (see attached)
  - a. If decision is made in FAVOR of allowing the Home Occupation, the members of the ZBA and the applicant / property owner all sign the DECLARATION OF COVENANTS HOME OCCUPATION SPECIAL PERMIT form
  - b. The ZBA notifies all abutters of the decision
- 4. The ZBA's Decision "NOTICE OF DECISION TO GRANT A SPECIAL PERMIT" and the DECLARATION OF COVENANTs form both go to the Town Clerk. The Clerk waits for 20 day "no appeal" period -- if there is no appeal (by an abutter)
  - a. The Clerk signs a Certificate of No Appeal
- 5. The applicant then takes the signed DECLARATION OF COVENANTS form **and** the signed Certificate of No Appeal and the NOTICE OF DECISION TO GRANT A SPECIAL PERMIT (from the ZBA)- including the ZBA Vote Sheet with signatures -- to the Registry of Deeds
- 6. The Registry of Deeds will stamp and sign the DECLARATION OF COVENANTS
- 7. The applicant will return this signed/stamped document a member of the ZBA will then sign /have signature Notarized and copies will be given to the ZBA, the Town Clerk and the Building Department at which time a building permit can be issued
